

Wortham ISD  
Transfer Policy Guidelines  
2010-'11

Transfer students seeking enrollment in Wortham ISD must meet the following criteria:

1. The transferring student must have passed all sections of the appropriate grade level state assessment during the previous school year.
2. The transferring student must have been in attendance 95% of time while enrolled in the school district from which the student is transferring during the previous school year.
3. The student must have met the state requirements for appropriate grade level credit or promotion for the current school year.
4. The transferring student shall have no more than three (3) PEIMS 425 discipline referrals (ISS) or suspensions during the current calendar year.
5. The transferring student shall have no more than two (2) prior DAEP placements and no DAEP placements during the past year.
6. Transferring students who require special programs, which are not in place in Wortham ISD, will not be accepted.
7. Transfer students must re-apply every year.

Wortham ISD transfer students will forfeit their transfer when:

1. The transfer student earns three (3) 425 Discipline Referrals (ISS).
2. The transfer student's attendance falls below 95% in a semester. This equates to 5 or more absences for one semester courses or 10 or more absences in a school year.
3. The transfer student fails one or more core courses in 2 consecutive six week grading periods in a school year.
4. The transfer student fails two or more core courses in one six weeks grading period.
5. The transfer student fails to earn grade level credit or be promoted to the next grade.
6. The transfer student is placed in DAEP.
7. Transfers will be denied/revoked on a last come first denied basis, when or if the number of transfer students in a particular grade or class would cause the district to require additional staffing or facilities.

Additional Required Documentation for Transfer Students

*Students seeking to transfer to Wortham ISD must have the following additional documentation on file before being considered for enrollment:*

1. Discipline Records for the current and past school year
2. Attendance Records for the current and past school year
3. Transcripts from all schools in which the student has attended
4. Report Card from the most recently completed semester
5. Most recent State Assessment Results (TAKS/SDAA II)
